2. Any group interaction or task you have in mind beyond traditional Q & A.
3. Any audio-visual devices that you would want us to provide.

It is entirely appropriate and often desirable to converse with me via email or phone prior to submission. My program committee and others as will help me plan the conference flow and balance the content.
