### **Ground transportation**

Estes Park Shuttle, at 970 586-5151, provides four scheduled daily trips from Denver International Airport to Lakeshore Lodge and other locations in Estes Park. The cost is \$39 one-way or \$75 round trip, per person. The trip takes approximately 2 hours. Reservations are suggested.

Estes Park Taxi, at (970) 577-TAXI, can also pick up at the airport. Cost is around \$120 for one person plus \$10 for each additional person. Call for information.

### **More about Lakeshore Lodge**

At 1700 Big Thompson Avenue, Lake Shore Lodge is located on Highway 34, on the north shore of Lake Estes. A two-hour drive from Denver International Airport, the Lodge is two miles from Rocky Mountain National Park, and is situated at an elevation of 7,522 feet.

Located adjacent to the Lake Estes Marina, Lake Shore Lodge can offer guests the opportunity to rent boats, mountain bikes, skates and other recreational equipment to enjoy Lake Estes and its surrounding area. A variety of local stables, including sister resort Aspen Lodge, make it easy to arrange for adventures with horses on high mountain trails.
